



Here are some youth volunteer ideas and ways you can be a Humane Hero!!

- Ask your teacher if your class or school can do a “Pennies for Paws” fundraiser; ask all the students and teachers to donate pennies or other change!
- Save your spare change in a jar and donate it to Humane Ohio (you can even do extra chores to earn money from your parents)!
- Make craft items, pet toys or treats and sell them at school or church and to friends and relatives and donate the proceeds to Humane Ohio!
- Make catnip pillows or pet beds (instructions at www.humaneohio.org in the “Get Involved” section, then click on “short term community service hour project list”) for us to sell at Humane Ohio or for us to give to our pet food bank clients!
- Hold a bake sale at your school and/or church and donate the proceeds to Humane Ohio!
- Offer to mow someone’s lawn, pick-up sticks in their yard, wash their car, etc. in return for a donation that you can give to Humane Ohio!
- Have a garage sale and donate the proceeds to Humane Ohio!
- Consign old clothes to benefit Humane Ohio!
- Ask friends/relatives to make donations to Humane Ohio in honor of your birthday or special occasion instead of gifts!
- Throw a birthday party for your pet and ask guests to bring items and supplies that can be donated to Humane Ohio instead of gifts for your spoiled pet!

- Organize a pet food drive for the Humane Ohio Pet Food Bank!
